Stimulus Payment Guide for Non-Filers

Only a Guide - Consult the IRS or US Treasury Websites for Most Up to Date Info

If you are a US CITIZEN with A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, you are entitled to receive a stimulus payment. The **amount** you will receive is dependent on your INCOME and TAX-FILING STATUS.

This GUIDE is specifically for people who do not TYPICALLY need to file taxes:

- INDIVIDUALS who made LESS THAN \$12,200 in 2019.
- MARRIED COUPLES who made less than \$24,400 in 2019.
- SSI & SSDI RECIPIENTS and VA BENEFICIARIES will automatically receive \$1,200. HOWEVER, *if you have dependents, you must use this form in order to receive additional money for your dependents.*

CONTINUE TO PAGE 2 TO BEGIN

(This process requires that you have internet access AND an e-mail address)

This GUIDE is NOT the best one for you IF you are:

- SINGLE and earned MORE THAN \$12,200 but LESS THAN \$99,000 during 2018 or 2019, you will receive a stimulus payment, but you must file a tax return.
- A HEAD OF HOUSEHOLD and earned LESS THAN \$146,500 during 2018 or 2019, you will receive a stimulus payment, but you must file a tax return.
- MARRIED and FILE JOINTLY and earned less than \$198,000 during 2018 or 2019, you will receive a stimulus payment, but you must file a tax return.

Who is eligible for the Economic Impact Payment?

U.S. citizens or resident aliens who:

- Have a valid Social Security number,
- Could not be claimed as a dependent of another taxpayer, and
- Had adjusted gross income under certain limits.

Who will receive the Economic Impact Payment automatically without taking additional steps?

Most eligible U.S. taxpayers will [automatically receive](#) their Economic Impact Payments including:

- Individuals who filed a federal income tax for 2018 or 2019
- Individuals who receive Social Security retirement, disability (SSDI), or survivor benefits
- Individuals who receive Railroad Retirement benefits

Information You will Need to Provide

- Full name, current mailing address and an email address
- Date of birth and valid Social Security number
- Bank account number, type and routing number, if you have one
- Identity Protection Personal Identification Number (IP PIN) you received from the IRS earlier this year, if you have one
- Driver's license or state-issued ID, if you have one
- For each qualifying child: name, Social Security number or Adoption Taxpayer Identification Number and their relationship to you or your spouse

If you don't usually file a tax return, submit your information here to get the Economic Impact Payment

If you receive veterans disability compensation, a pension, or survivor benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs, or your income level does not require you to file a tax return, then you need to submit information to the IRS to receive an Economic Impact Payment.

Complete this free online form so that the IRS can identify you and your dependents, and receive valid direct deposit and address information about you. This information allows the IRS to calculate your eligibility and send you the Economic Impact Payment.

Do NOT continue here if:

- You receive Social Security, Railroad Retirement, or SSDI benefits. The IRS will automatically send you an Economic Impact Payment.
- You have already filed a 2019 federal income tax return.
- Your 2019 gross income exceeded \$12,200 (\$24,400 for a married couple) or other reasons require you to file a 2019 federal tax return.
- You were married at the end of 2019 and are not submitting information here with your spouse.
- You were not a U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident in 2019.

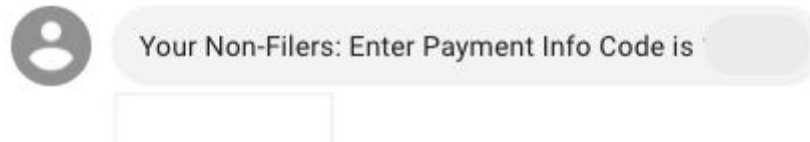

If you filed taxes in 2018 and are unsure of your AGI, request your transcript here:

If you earned less than \$12,200 during 2018, enter a zero on the Taxpayer line.
