HAP's offices are temporarily closed, our clinics are currently canceled through the end of April, and our staff is working safely from home. We're following up on our cases, checking in often with our sheltered friends and case worker personnel, and brainstorming about how to best serve our clients in this challenging environment. Current clients are able to reach their HAP attorneys by phone or email and HAP is returning inquiries for help left on its general line.

We are also diligently working to ensure that all those in shelter will be able to expeditiously access their personal stimulus checks of \$1,200 — even if they have not filed a tax return in the recent past.

We are concerned about what would happen to our clients if COVID-19 were to spread in any given shelter and we are participating in **ongoing discussions with the City** regarding finding and opening isolation sites in time.
